Section times

In sections 4 and 6, Irvine smashed the existing records set by Bellahouston in 2013

Dave Millar ran the hilly 15½-mile section 4 in 1:38, 8 minutes faster than the record.

Alex Allardyce ran his 14-mile section 6 in 1:30, lopping 11 minutes off the record.
